The Choir is made up of three sections: 1<sup>st</sup> Soprano, Mezzo Soprano and Alto. The Altos split into 2 parts for some of our pieces.

The Musical Director will arrange to listen to your voice in private after a few weeks to help decide which section is best for your voice.

Once you have been assigned to a section, please get to know your singing colleagues and have fun.

## *Rehearsals*

We meet at the Village Hall, Hullbridge Road on Tuesday evenings commencing at 8.15pm prompt, finishing at 9.45pm.

There are no rehearsals in August.

Additional rehearsals are sometimes arranged prior to a Concert and are usually on a Sunday evening.

We sometimes sit within our sections for rehearsals but may be mixed up to give us a better appreciation of the other parts and allow us to become confident in singing against them. When we are mixed, we all sit with a singing buddy of the same section for moral support.

## Music

All music provided to you remains the property of the Swift Singers and we ask that only pencil is used to mark music, **no ink or highlighter pen.**

Please note it is illegal to photocopy music. If you are missing music or lose a piece of music, please speak to the Librarian who will arrange a replacement.

Although provision of your music is included in your subscription, any replacements will need to be paid for.

## Concerts

It is the Swift Singers' policy that new members must attend a total of **24** rehearsals before participating in a concert in order to give plenty of time to learn the music. In order to take part in any concert, all members are expected to attend **8 out of the last 12** rehearsals, and **2 out of the last 3**, before each concert. Please check with your section Leader if you are unsure about qualification.

All members are expected to learn all the **Music and Words** for each concert.

## Subscriptions

Our annual subscription charges are currently £135 payable in three equal instalments of £45 in January, April and September. As we are a registered charity these subscriptions qualify for Gift Aid. A Gift Aid Declaration is included with this pack for completion if you are a taxpayer. The additional revenue received by the Swift Singers from this scheme enables us to keep our subscription charge low, so please complete the form if you can. You can speak to our Treasurer who will give you any advice you may require.

## Uniform

Our current uniform for concerts is black trousers with a black/gold jacket and black t-shirt. We also have a black musical scarf that we sometimes wear instead of the jacket for a more informal appearance.



The jacket will be provided to you as required for each concert. You may be given one on permanent loan but can be asked to lend this to another choir member if you are not participating in a concert. The jacket is not machine washable and should be dry cleaned when necessary.

We make a charge of £3.50 for a musical scarf which is yours to keep if you decide to leave the choir. We ask you to provide your own tailored black trousers (no leggings or jeans) and a short sleeved, scoop neck black t shirt. Once you qualify for a concert, the uniform co-ordinator will ensure you have all the items you require.

Please wear black shoes and black tights/socks.
